

**Mei Carmel Ltd. Haifa's Water and Sewage Corporation**

**INFORMATION FOR THE RESIDENT  
PREPARATIONS FOR A STATE OF EMERGENCY**

A water crisis is a situation in which there is a significant and unplanned disruption in the regular supply of water to the residents' homes. This situation may happen in times of war; however, a state of emergency can also take place during routine time and with no prior warning, due to significant damage to the city's water sources and the water and sewage infrastructure. This event may occur as a result of a prolonged power outage, damage or natural disasters, such as: earthquake, fires, etc.

**The Mei Carmel Corporation is optimally prepared to cope and function during a time of crisis until the quick return to routine.**

The Mei Carmel Water and Sewage Corporation, together with the Haifa Municipality, Mekorot Ltd. and the Water Authority, is prepared to handle incidents involving damage to the water and sewage system, including the distribution of water to the residents, by deploying water distribution stations citywide (the distribution points and information regarding their operation hours are found on the corporation's website), all this until the systems resumes to its normal functioning.

**RESIDENT'S PREPARATIONS – WATER AND SANITATION KIT**

**In order to improve the civil preparedness and as an immediate solution, we recommend that each household have a kit that includes:**

**12 liters per person**

Based on the number of persons living at home  
The water will be used for drinking and cooking

**Garbage and Sanitation Bags**

Designed to maintain cleanliness of the surroundings and to prevent sanitation hazards and for sanitary needs.

**Wet Wipes of Anti-bacterial gel**

Designed to maintain personal hygiene and conserve drinking water

**Disposable dishes and paper towels**

Designed to avoid the need to wash dishes and for personal hygiene.

We recommend storing the kit in the protective space, in a shady and accessible location.

The aforementioned items can be purchased at supermarkets and grocery stores.
